Criminal History Policy: Criminal Background Check and Preliminary Criminal History Evaluation

Texas Certification seeking applicants/candidates read and sign this acknowledgement form

Pursuant to the Texas Education Code (TEC), §22.083, candiscate in general certification must undergo a criminal history background check prior to employment as an educator particular to TEC, §22.0835, prior clinical teaching

OLLU's exascertification/educator preparation program requires that applicants and candidates have a clear criminal history background check (nationwide) PRIDAM mittance into the educator preparation program or a favorable Preliminary Criminal History Evaluation letter from TEA about their potential eligibility for educator certification. Applicants with certain criminal convictions or deferred adjudications may not be eligible for placement and thus not able to pursue certification. For more information candidate review Texas Occupation Code, Chapter 53, Section 53500105 and/or Texas Administrative 2430 650 bph apter B \$249.16.

Applicants and/or candidates of the following:

- 1) Having a criminal history might preveapplicants from attaining a placement and/or completing their clinical teaching or becoming certified educators on the following factors:
  - x the nature and seriousness of the crime;
  - x the relationship of the crime to the purposes that certification is required to become a professional educator:
  - x the extent to which certification might offer an opportunity to engage in further criminal activity of the same type as that in which the person previously had been involved;
  - x the relationship of the crime to the ability, capacity, or fitness required to perform the duties of a professional educator;
  - x the extent of the applicant's past criminal activity;
  - x the age of the person when the crime was committed;
  - x the amount of time that has elapsed since the person's last criminal activity;
  - x the conduct and work activity
